

EVALUATION LICENSE

Apogee Software, Inc., a California corporation with a place of business at 1999 South Bascom Ave., Suite 250, Campbell, CA, USA (“Apogee”) hereby grants to _____, _____ with a place of business at _____ (“Evaluator”) this Evaluation License (“License”) effective as of _____, 2011, (“Effective Date”) for the evaluation version of Apogee’s Java Runtime Environment (“Eval JRE”). The Eval JRE is provided in a configuration requested in Exhibit A of this License and is targeted at an OS/Processor platform (“Target Platform”) requested in Exhibit B of this License. The Eval CJRE is provided in executable form only.

License Terms

By downloading the Eval JRE from Apogee’s website or obtaining it from Apogee by any other means, and by installing the Eval JRE on at least one Target Platform, the Evaluator hereby agrees to the following terms:

1. The License is granted for the period of 60 (sixty) days (“Evaluation Period”).
2. Apogee grants to Evaluator a non-transferable, non-exclusive, time-limited and royalty-free evaluation license to use the Eval CRE from the Effective Date for the duration of Evaluation Period.
3. After the Evaluation Period will expire, Evaluator shall destroy or purge all copies of the Eval CJRE and send email to Apogee declaring that this has been done.
4. The Evaluator is permitted to install up to 3 (three) copies of Eval CJRE on the Target Platforms located on Evaluator’s premises.
5. The Evaluator is permitted to use each installed copy of Eval CJRE for evaluation purposes only.
6. Evaluator is not permitted to use any installed copy of Eval CJRE in creating Java applications that are meant to become the commercial products to be marketed by Evaluator.
7. Evaluator acknowledges that the Eval CJRE is not a production version, which means that it has not been subjected to the quality assurance normally applied by Apogee to completed products.
8. The Evaluator shall report to the Apogee any defects or failures of correct operation of Eval CJRE, and shall include adequate supporting data, so each failure can be reproduced, if possible, by Apogee.
9. The Evaluator shall share with the Apogee the performance data obtained with the Eval CJRE for any publicly available benchmarks.
10. The Evaluator is not permitted to disseminate any data concerning any defects or failures of correct operation of Eval CJRE, as well as any performance data, to third parties without written permission by Apogee. All such data are for internal use only and disclosure to any outside party is strictly prohibited.
11. Evaluator acknowledges that the Eval CJRE is the property of Apogee and IBM, and that the Eval CJRE including the intellectual property therein and the copyrights and trademarks related thereto, is proprietary to Apogee and IBM.
12. Evaluator shall not sell, license, transfer, disclose, display or otherwise make available the Eval CJRE to any third parties.
13. Evaluator shall not let any third party use any copy of Eval CJRE unless specifically permitted in writing by Apogee.
14. Apogee and IBM have expended substantial resources on creating the Eval CJRE, and have substantial proprietary interests and valuable trade secrets in the Eval CJRE. Therefore, Evaluator agrees to hold confidential and to secure and protect the Eval CJRE and any data resulting from its use in order to maintain the proprietary rights of Apogee and IBM and in order to honor the restrictions of this License.
